6.1 Atlantic Wind and Solar Inc., Municipal Support Resolution for a solar ground-mount project

WHEREAS Fryer Forest Products Ltd (the "Applicant") proposes to construct and operate a ground mount solar (the "Project") on Martland Township, Concession 4, S PT Lot 7, Parcel 1141 (the "Property") in the Municipality of French River under the Province's FIT Program; and

WHEREAS the Applicant has requested that Council of Municipality of French River indicate by resolution Council's support for the construction and operation of the Project on the Property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the rules governing the FIT Program (the "FIT Rules"), Applications whose Projects receive the formal support of Municipalities will be awarded priority points, which may result in the Applicant being offered a FIT Contract prior to other persons applying for FIT Contracts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality of French River hereby supports the construction and operation of the Project on the Lands.

6.2 French River Delta Association/French River Stewardship Council, Request to adopt a resolution opposing the Allen-Struthers, Wanapitei River proposed modified run-of-river hydroelectric dam

WHEREAS Xeneca Power Development Inc. is proposing a Modified Run-of-River Hydroelectric Dam for the Wanapitei River, to be located at the Sturgeon Chutes, 200 metres from the Provincial Park boundary in Allen and Struthers townships; and

WHEREAS the Municipality of French River is in favour of responsible and sustainable green energy projects that have had the input, consensus and blessing of the municipalities affected; and

WHEREAS the modified run-of-river operating strategy would involve holding river flow back for up to 48 hours to fill up to 12 km of head ponds, and exposure to solar warming for up to 32 hours; and

WHEREAS there are 3 Waste Water Treatment Facilities releasing treated, undertreated and untreated effluent into the Wanapitei River Watershed, the cumulative negative effects could result in an increased incidence of toxic algae blooms, and an unnecessary risk to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS as seen in Sturgeon Bay in the Township of the Archipelago, blue green algae blooms combined with water use advisories negatively affect the property values; and

WHEREAS the modified peaking operating strategy would create extreme and frequent river flow velocity and water level changes on the Wanapitei River throughout the majority of the year, this could have an unacceptable negative impact on ice stability and year-round recreational activities such as swimming, boating, snowmobiling, skiing, ice and summer fishing, and create a public safety hazard and/or economic loss in tourism dollars; and

WHEREAS the operating of the dam will cause unacceptable change to a major spawning and nursery site in the French River Delta for Walleye, Lake Sturgeon, Muskellunge, Northern Pike and other species; and

WHEREAS the dam's operation, infrastructure, roads and transmission line could negatively affect the elk recovery program as well as the moose wintering yards; and

WHEREAS the operation of the dam will negatively affect the sustainability and recovery of multiple endangered and threatened species including: Lake Sturgeon, Blanding Turtles, Northern Map Turtles, Snapping Turtles, Whippoorwill, Bald Eagles, and Osprey; and

WHEREAS the Allen-Struthers project is reported to have a total Installed Capacity (IC) of 2.8 MW, when due to seasonal flows the actual real energy produced by these dams would be generously predicted to be more like 1.7 MW of power generated; and

WHEREAS the demand for power in Ontario has been significantly reduced in recent years, and there is much more that can be achieved through energy conservation and efficiencies before resorting to this project; and

WHEREAS it has come to our attention that no dam decommissioning provisions are being made for any proposed hydroelectric dams in Ontario, and with scientists' predictions of climate change to bring increasing drought conditions, there is a possibility that these dams will no longer be environmentally, ecologically, economically or socially feasible in the near future, and in that case, removal of these dams would be left to the taxpayers, and this would be unacceptable; and

WHEREAS the operation of the dam would cause damage to the French River Provincial Park, which is prohibited by Ontario policy.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality of French River strongly opposes this proposal for Allen-Struthers, Wanapitei River due to the numerous negative impacts affecting water quality, water quantity, public health and safety, destruction of fish habitat and spawning areas, and the overall environmental, ecological, social and economic costs that could result from this proposed modified run-of-river hydroelectric dam.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT communication of this decision will be made to Xeneca Power Development Inc, the Premier, Minister of Energy, Minister of Environment, Minister of Natural Resources, and also published in the local newspapers.
